1. Petitioner-Pulkit seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.464, dated 24.4.2019, registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC.
2. The FIR came to be lodged at the instance of Vinkal Bajan wherein he has alleged that on the day of occurrence when he was present at a “ladies sangeet” function, he was caught hold of by Anuj Gupta, Ankush Garg and Ravinder and that Pulkit Mangla hit him on his head with an empty liquor bottle, as a result of which he fell down and blood started oozing from the head. It is further alleged that the aforesaid persons gave kicks and fist blows to him while he was lying down.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and that in any case since no grievous injury has been caused to the complainant the petitioner deserves concession of anticipatory bail.
4. Opposing the petition, learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Dalbir Singh, has informed that the complainant sustained a cut injury on his head measuring 1 cm x .2 cm i.e. on fronto parietal region. It has however, been informed that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.
5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and while bearing in mind that it is a case of a single injury which has been opined to be a simple injury and also that the petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case, the petition is accepted. In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
