This order shall dispose of the CRM-M-44722-2018 titled as
“Balwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others” and CRM-M-
45054-2018 titled as “Ranjit Singh vs. State of Punjab and another”. The
above said petitions have been filed for quashing of FIR No.80 dated

10.07.2012 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 326, 323, 324, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar along with cross version i.e. DDR No.22 dated 11.07.2012 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 323, 324 & 506 of Indian Penal Code with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 14.09.2018 (Annexure P-3). For brevity, facts have been taken from CRM-M-44722-2018.

In this case, Balvir Singh has received grievous injuries on little finger and also received other injuries on the back and hip. Balvir Singh has now died. The accused have entered into compromise with the legal heirs of the said Balvir Singh.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar has been received that the statement of Gurdev Kaur-wife of Balvir Singh, his two sons namely Ranjit Singh and Kuldeep Singh and all the accused has been recorded. It is stated that both the parties have entered into compromise with their free consent and without any pressure, coercion, undue influence and inducement.

The trial is stated to be pending for prosecution evidence. As the parties have effected compromise, the case is unlikely to succeed. Therefore, the continuation of proceedings before the trial Court will be useless exercise. As such, FIR No.80 dated 10.07.2012 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 326, 323, 324, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar along with cross version i.e. DDR No.22 dated 11.07.2012 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 323, 324 &

506 of Indian Penal Code with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, stand quashed qua the petitioner(s).

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed.
