This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 -Additional Chief Secretary -cum- Commissioner Development and Panchayat Department, Haryana to take up appeal No. 43 of 2019 titled Dharampal vs. D.C. Panchkula for preliminary hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.1 -Additional Chief Secretary -cum- Commissioner Development and Panchayat Department, Haryana to take up appeal No. 43 of 2019 titled Dharampal vs. D.C. Panchkula and decide the same expeditiously.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the

However, in case, the appellate authority is unable to decide the same, at least ensure that the stay application filed alongwith the appeal is adjudicated upon preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment.

Operation and effect of order dated 12.4.2019 (Annexure P-7) shall remain stayed till the disposal of the application for stay filed by the petitioner.
