This present petition is of petitioner-Kashmir Singh seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.65 dated 26.08.2018 under Sections 406/498-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Women, District Amritsar.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Partap Singh, Police Station Women, District Amritsar, submits that petitioner-Kashmir Singh, in consequence of order dated 15.01.2019 has joined the investigations and returned the articles of *Istridhan* and the parties have effected a settlement which fact is not displaced by learned counsel for the petitioner who has also placed on record attested true typed copies of the settlement/agreement.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigations and nothing is to be recovered from him, in view of this, in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, the petitioner will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
