The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.75 dated 05.03.2018, registered under Sections 376, 387, 50 IPC, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

As per prosecution version, the petitioner committed rape upon the prosecutrix by threatening her to put acid on her and lateron he threatened her to get her and her husband killed and duped Rs.1,70,000/- from her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the photographs placed on record transpire that both the petitioner and the prosecutrix have friendly relations and her messages show that she loves the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

The serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. The probative value of the photographs and SMS (short messages service) shall be considered at an appropriate stage of trial.

Therefore, finding no ground to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner, the instant petition stands dismissed.
