Petitioner is participating in the selection process for the post of Constable (Male) under the General category. Last candidate selected in the General category has secured 57 marks. As per individual marks uploaded on the website of respondent-Commission, petitioner has secured 52.2 marks. He has been awarded 05 marks under the Socio-Economic criteria as none of his family members is in Govt. job. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per certificate dated 20.09.2018 (Annexure P-9) issued by the Tehsildar, Kaithal, petitioner is an orphan, therefore, 05 more marks should have been awarded to him. In case, the petitioner is awarded 05 more marks, he will be in the waiting list.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, present petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to verify the certificate dated 20.09.2018 (Annexure

P-9) stating the petitioner to be orphan and thereafter, consider awarding of

05 marks to the petitioner under the Socio-Economic criteria. After doing so, respondent-Commission can revise the merit of petitioner and consider him for appointment against the vacant post. This exercise be completed within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
