FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Chetan Puri in case registered by way of FIR No.61 dated 29.09.2018 at Police Station Women, District Yamuna Nagar under Sections 498-A, 323, 406, 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 10.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Kaur, Police Station Women, District Yamuna Nagar who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered

from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view thereof and the fact that the parties have effected a compromise which is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant Mr. Sunny Dhull, Advocate and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.10.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
