GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.29 dated 7.9.2018 under Sections 346, 498-A, 323 & 506 IPC, Police Station Sector 17, Faridabad.
2. The FIR was lodged at the instance of Shyamwati wherein it has been alleged that the complainant had been harassed by the petitioner on account of demand of dowry.
3. Pursuant to the interim directions issued by this Court on 7th March, 2019, the parties appeared before Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Palwal wherein efforts were made to work out some amicable settlement. Report of Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Palwal has been received accompanied by compromise effected by the parties.
4. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the matter is stated to have

been amicably resolved, this Court does not find any ground for warranting custodial interrogation. Accordingly the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 10.10.2018 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
