This common order shall dispose of above noted two petitions
as they arise out of the same FIR.

These petitions have been filed under Section 438 of the Code
of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioners Sunil
Kumar and Jitender Kumar in case FIR No. 573 dated 21.11.2018,
registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 409, 468, 471 of the IPC and Sections

7 and 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for both the petitioners submit that the petitioners have joined investigation in compliance with the order dated 17.05.2019. It is further submitted that the disputed amount has already been deposited by co-accused Injderjeet.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Investigating Officer/ASI Gajraj Singh regarding role of SDO Manpal, in which it is stated that he was not found at fault.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gajraj Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, these petitions are allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 17.05.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
