Prayer in this application is for amendment of memo of parties with a further prayer for correction of typographical error in the order dated 08.05.2019 where inadvertently, instead of 17.10.2018, the date of issuance of *Sanad Takseem* is mentioned as 17.10.2019. Further prayer is for placing on record *Sanad Takseem* (Annexure P-2).

Prayer made in the application is allowed. Amended memo of parties appended with the application is taken on record and the order dated 08.05.2019 passed by this Court wherein there is typographical error relating to the issuance of *Sanad Takseem*, is corrected which may be read as 17.10.2018 instead of 17.10.2019.

Let the Registry carry out necessary correction in the said order.

As regard to the prayer for placing on record *Sanad Takseem*,

the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions and *Sanad Takseem*

(Annexure P-2) is taken on record.

CM stands disposed of.

CWP No.12113 of 2019

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that after issuance of *Sanad Takseem* dated 17.10.2018, no action has been taken by the respondents for handing over the possession to the parties. He contends that said order of *Sanad Takseem* dated 17.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) has attained finality as there has been no challenge thereto. Faced with this situation, petitioner has served a legal notice dated 28.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) upon respondent Nos.1 to 3 but till date no response thereto has been received.

Copy of the writ petition has already been supplied to the office of Advocate General, Punjab. Therefore, on the asking of the Court, Mr.T.P.S.Chawla, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and take a decision upon the legal notice dated 28.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) served on behalf of the petitioner, within a period of two months from today. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner and in case merit is found in the legal notice, further steps be taken in accordance with law.
