The present petition is directed against the order dated 08.04.2019 passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division) Chandigarh (for short – the Trial Court) through which during the pendency of the petition pending between the parties under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 (for short – the Act) visitation rights have been granted to the petitioner to meet his minor child on the 3rd Saturday of every month from 2.00 P.M. to 4.00 P.M. in the ADR/Mediation Centre, Chandigarh.

In pursuance to the directions of this Court, the parties alongwith their minor child, appeared before this Court with whom the matter was discussed. After such discussion as also meeting the minor child, this Court is of the opinion that during the pendency of the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 25 of the Act, the petitioner be permitted to meet his minor child on every Sunday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. On every Sunday, the respondent-wife shall hand over the custody of the minor child of the parties to the petitioner outside Shri Gurudwara Sahib, Sector-8,

Chandigarh at 9:00 A.M. and shall take his custody from the petitioner back from the same place at 5:00 P.M.

The Trial Court is directed to dispose of the main petition expeditiously but not later than three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order after giving both parties three effective opportunities each to lead their evidence.

The litigation expenses of Rs.11,000/- deposited by the petitioner in this Court be disbursed to the respondent-wife.

The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
