The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.85 dated 09.08.2018, registered under Sections 323, 342, 354, 354-A, 354-B, 354-D, 376 (2) (n) IPC, at Police Station Woman Panipat.

It has been contended that earlier the prosecutrix was live-in-relationship with the petitioner. She alleged that in April, 2018, the petitioner had withdrawn Rs.10,000/- from her bank account and she lodged a complaint to the bank. It has been further contended that the FIR has been filed at a belated stage.

Learned State counsel has submitted that six witnesses including the prosecutrix has been examined and he has placed on record the deposition of the prosecutrix. Same is taken on record.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 15.08.2018. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by

keeping the petitioner in custody any further

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Vikasdeep is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
