During the course of interaction, both the husband - Mr. Bhupender Singh Jamwal (petitioner) and wife – Ms. Sangeeta Jamwal (respondent No.2) have made their respective statements that it was a voluntary act in settling the dispute which was without any coercion, influence or threat and had themselves placed on the record attested copy of their mediation referral order along with attested copy of the settlement agreement dated 05.10.2018 along with letter by the Mediator, Faridabad addressed to the court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Faridabad to this effect.

Since the parties have mutually settled all their disputes which have been well detailed in the settlement agreement and the respective

parties would withdraw/withdrawn all civil and criminal cases filed against each other arising out of this matrimonial disaccord till date, undertaking further that they would not institute fresh case against each other henceforth.

Since the parties as per the settlement filed before the Court in writing and as per their statements before this Court, vouching for the same have settled all their disputes and the offences for which petitioner – Bhupinder Singh Jamwal has been hauled up are not of serious in nature and in view of the law laid down in ***Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another***, reported in ***2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543*** and ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another***, reported in ***2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052***, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 401, dated 28.06.2016, under Sections 498-A, 323, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, Faridabad and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
