Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to to save guard the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members, at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), is directed to look into the matter in a time-bound manner.

A perusal of record shows that there is no representation moved on behalf of the petitioner to any of the police authorities. Therefore, instant petition is liable to be dismissed.

However, having heard learned counsel for the petitioner,

instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2–
