Petitioner, a female, prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.61 dated 28.02.2019 registered under Sections 379 and 473 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 411, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 489 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code were added lateron) at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

This case is triable by the Magistrate. The petitioner is in custody for the last two months and eleven days. Investigations are complete. Challan has been presented.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner is also accused in two other criminal cases. He has drawn attention of this Court to the affidavit of custody wherein the petitioner is an accused in FIR No. 55 dated 19.02.2019 under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sohana and FIR No. 17 dated 20.02.2019 under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Phase-08 Mohali. Hence, all the three FIRs are within the span of nine days.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
