Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 14.01.2019 passed by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No.78 dated 21.06.2018 under Sections 376, 506 and 120-B IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar.

Prayer has also been made for quashing of the aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise dated 24.01.2019 entered into between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner restricts his prayer so far as the impugned order dated 14.01.2019 passed by learned Magistrate declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender

is concerned. However, he seeks liberty to file a fresh petition regarding quashing of the aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn for the relief seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and to face the trial in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghuman, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Lest it may delay the proceedings any more, but without observing anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within two weeks from today, he shall be admitted on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
