**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.03 dated 04.01.2019, under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that a bag containing Tramadol tablets with a total weight of 782 grams was allegedly recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody for over almost a year since his arrest on 04.01.2019. He is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act. She also contends that the petitioner is a physically handicapped being polio inflicted which is also mentioned in the FIR itself.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, states that 4 out of 14 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost a year, he is physically handicapped and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
