This is a petition for blanket bail. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner on the last date and even today on the second call none has entered appearance.

Learned DAG, Punjab states that para 5 of the reply is to the following effect :-

“That it is respectfully submitted that the SSP, District SAS Nagar has looked into the grievance of the petitioner and as per the request of the petitioner, the SIT under the supervision of IPS officer is conducting the investigation of the FIRs registered against him alongwith the representations (Annexure P-15 and P-16). As regards the prayer made by the petitioner in the present petition to serve him an advance notice of 7 days prior to his arrest, the SSP District SAS Nagar has directed all the SHOs in the District SAS Nagar to serve the petitioner an advance notice of 7 days to the petitioner in case he is required to be arrested. Thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.”

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
