The situation is the same as was on the last date of hearing, with the report of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal, dated 18.10.2019 being on record, stating that the petitioner was arrested by police officials and thereafter granted bail by that court, with the earlier report dated 08.08.2019 being that despite the orders of this Court dated 03.06.2019 and 12.07.2019, the petitioner had not surrendered before that court.

That being so, I see no reason to entertain this petition, which as a matter of fact having been rendered infructuous, the petitioner having been admitted to bail by the trial court itself, upon him having been arrested.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
