The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 837, dated 21.09.2016, registered at Police Station City Ballabgarh, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 11.10.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Smt. Kailashi Devi wife of Shri Kanhi Ram and also of petitioners/accused Satyawati wife of Surender Kumar and Prem Chand son of Shri Nohre Mal have been recorded

to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that he has no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, opined that the compromise arrived between the parties is true, genuine, voluntary, without any pressure or undue influence and out of their own free will.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in **2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab**, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 837, dated 21.09.2016, registered at Police Station City Ballabgarh, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
