Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry in case FIR No. 25 dated 11.03.2017, under Sections 409, 420, 120-B of the IPC and Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Reply, filed by way of affidavit of S.S.P., Hoshiarpur, dated 24.08.2018, is on record. As per reply, the FIR was registered against Amit Kumar Chadha, Cashier, Pankaj Salhotra, Policy Head, Harkesh Kumar, Personal Banker, Rohit Thakur, Branch Manager, Amit Kumar, Vice Manager and Kapil Trehan, Cluster Head.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, submits that during investigation, Kapil Trehan was found innocent and two other accused Pankaj Salhotra and Amit Kumar Chadha were arrested and challan qua them shall be presented shortly.

It is further submitted by learned State counsel that proceedings

to declare Harkesh Kumar as a proclaimed offender are pending before the trial Court and challan qua Rohit Thakur and Amit Kumar has already been presented.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
