**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajak Singh Women Police Station, District Amritsar submits that the petitioner is not required for investigation and recovery has already been effected from him and that he has no objection if the interim direction dated 12.10.2018 is made absolute.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel that the interim direction granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.10.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
