MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.74 dated 10.08.2018 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 379 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bakshiwal, District Patiala.

On 12.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the alleged injury mentioned in the FIR has attracted the offence under Section 323 IPC only and even otherwise, there was free fight between the parties.

Notice of motion for 24.01.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of

the order dated 12.10.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagdev Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.10.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
