This petition has been filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.120 dated 9.4.2017, registered under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC and 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana during the pendency of the trial.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he fired a shot at the complainant with an intention to kill him. However, the complainant managed to escape by sitting down at once and the bullet hit on his right arm. The petitioner has annexed the medical report of the complainant (Annexure P-1), as per which, he has suffered three injuries, two are grievous and one is simple in nature.

As of now, two witnesses which includes the complainant have been examined. The petitioner has been in custody since 13.11.2017. Trial of the case may take a long time. All other co-accused have already been released on bail, though learned State counsel states that one of them has jumped bail.

In view of the facts of the case, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
