Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.06 dated 14.01.2018 under Sections 20, 25 and 29 of NDPS Act 1985, registered at Police Station Mehal Kalan, District Barnala.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Parminder Singh, submits that the trial is going on and the prosecution would complete its entire evidence on the next two dates. The next date fixed before the trial Court is 11.06.2019 and some of the witnesses shall be examined on this date and the remaining witnesses shall be examined before the trial Court on the date to be next fixed by the trial Court. Still further, it is submitted that in any case, the evidence of the prosecution shall be completed within a period of two months from the next date fixed before the trial Court.

In view of the above, this Court does not deem it appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner, at this stage. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the prosecution is directed to complete its evidence by 13.09.2019, without fail.
