This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 25.1.2019 passed in CRM-M-3611 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of above, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-1) and decide the same expeditiously preferably within 90 days, as per law, after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of."

Respondent had filed reply with advance copy to counsel for the petitioner. Along with reply, order dated 22.3.2019 and inquiry report dated 10.4.2019 is annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the inquiry report and order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
