By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.218 dated 17.10.2016, under Sections 377, 365, 328, 34 IPC and Sections 7 and 8 of POSCO Act, registered at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar.

On 09.5.2019, this Court had passed the following order :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were neither named in the FIR nor even associated in the investigation. According to him after completion of investigation, final report was submitted against Anil Kumar @ Sonu and Gurpreet @ Gopi. It is contended that vide order dated 04.8.2018, the

petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.. It is pointed out that the matter is fixed before the trial Court for tomorrow i.e. 10.5.2019. According to learned counsel the investigation of the case is complete and the petitioners are not required for the same, muchless for custodial interrogation.

Notice of motion for 04.9.2019.

In case the petitioners submit themselves before the trial Court, the trial Court shall admit them on interim regular bail.”

In compliance of the said order, the petitioners submitted themselves before the trial Court on 28.5.2019 and furnished the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds, which were accepted by the trial Court. Copy of the order dated 28.5.2019 passed by the trial Court has been placed on record.

This fact is not disputed by learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Resham Singh.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioners shall remain on bail and on the same bail bonds and surety bonds already furnished by them before the trial Court, in compliance of order dated 09.5.2019 passed by this Court.
