Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.07 dated 04.01.2015 under Sections 394, 397 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, 1959, Police Station Gannaur, District Sonapat.

On 14.05.2019, the following order was passed while noting the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner:-

“Counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged incident is of January 2015 and the FIR was registered on 03.01.2015. The petitioner has been implicated on the basis of a supplementary statement of the alleged injured on 08.10.2018.

Learned State counsel prays for time to file the reply.

Adjourned to 27.05.2019.”

Learned counsel appearing for State of Haryana has filed the status report in which this fact is not disputed. The investigation is complete and the challan has been presented. The petitioner is in custody

since 01.11.2018.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
