Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.814 dated 02.12.2018 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 307, 452, 506, IPC, Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while drawing attention of the Court to Annexure P-3, a civil suit filed by father of the complainant against the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. He also draws attention of the Court to Annexure P-2, a copy of the FIR which was registered at the behest of wife of the petitioner on 04.05.2017 against the complainant.

Learned State counsel has submitted that only the petitioner has been arrested and the investigation against him is complete. The challan has been presented in Court. The petitioner is alleged to have caused injury with blunt weapon.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Nuh.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
