The petitioner approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in case registered against him vide FIR No.405 dated 04.05.2018 under Sections 379-B/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Chandani Bag, District Panipat.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Subhash Chand has informed that in fact the entire prosecution evidence has already been recorded and matter is fixed today before the trial Court for final arguments.

In view of the aforestated position, this Court is of the opinion that the present petition pertaining to grant of regular bail during pendency of trial is virtually rendered infructuous for the reasons that trial has almost concluded. The petition, as such is dismissed.
