Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to quash the order dated 21.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed absconder.

Counsel for the petitioner states that FIR No.197 dated 26.08.2016, under Sections 363, 366-A of IPC, Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana, was registered at the behest of Nirmal Singh (complainant). The daughter of the complainant has solemnized marriage with the petitioner and they are staying together as husband and wife. Even out of their wedlock, they have been blessed with a girl child on 26.09.2017. The petitioner has also filed CRM-M-21208-2019 seeking quashing of FIR No.197 (supra) which is listed for hearing on 23.08.2019. He further states that the petitioner is ready to surrender/appear before the trial Court and to face trial in accordance with law.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG,
Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel
during the course of the day.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with a
direction that in case the petitioner surrenders/appears before the trial Court
within 15 days from today and give an undertaking that he will appear
before the trial Court and face trial in accordance with law, the trial Court
shall admit him on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety
bonds to its satisfaction.
