On 08.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“Simran and Sahil, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 and 5. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-1 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 03.05.2019, Annexure P-6 to respondent No.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 16.05.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that now parents of petitioner no.1 have accepted the marriage between the petitioners and therefore, now there is no threat to their life and liberty.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
