ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.657 dated 09.09.2018, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station DLF, Sector-29, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of monetary dispute which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. He further contends that the petitioners have paid the entire amount in terms of the settlement to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the matter has indeed been compromised between the parties.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 12.10.2018, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be

released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mukesh Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 12.10.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
