MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0009 dated 18.01.2019 under Section 307 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City-I Abohar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.05.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was 17 years and 11 months old on the alleged date of occurrence. According to him, the injuries suffered by the victim were not on the vital parts of his body and it is seriously debatable as to whether offence punishable under Section 307 IPC is made out.

Notice of motion for 21.05.2019.”

It is not disputed by learned State counsel who is assisted by SI Harbhajan Singh as well as learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 that

the injury suffered by the victim are on the non-vital part of his body.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the matter has been compromised between the parties, which is not disputed by learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3.

In view of the above, it is ordered, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall join investigation as and when called for by the Investigating Officer. However, it is made clear that this order shall remain operative till the filing of the final report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
