Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.236 dated 14.11.2017 under Sections 307, 452, 506 and 120-B IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Phase 1, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR are that Sunny and Palwinder Singh along with five unknown persons entered the shop of the complainant, picked him and threw him from the first floor of the shop which led to the fracture on toe of his right leg. The present petitioner was not named in the FIR and the co-accused, namely, Sunny has been released on regular bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 7.3.2019 in CRM-M-042630 of 2018.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 20.11.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI-Sulekh Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner has joined investigation and co-accused has already been granted regular bail, the order dated 20.11.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
