This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.192 dated 19.12.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 458, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further states that offence punishable under Section 458 IPC stands deleted and the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Sushil Kumar does not dispute the above said fact.

In view of the above, it is ordered, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on bail subject to his

furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall join investigation as and when called for by the Investigating Officer. However, it is made clear that this order shall remain operative till the filing of the final report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
