Petitioner, who was serving on the post of Inspector Grade-II in the Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd., was placed under suspension vide order dated 22.11.2018 passed by the Managing Director of the Corporation at Annexure P-1.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that till date no formal initiation of a departmental inquiry has been made and neither has any subsistence allowance been released.

Counsel would make a submission that he would be satisfied, if, the writ petition was to be disposed of with a direction to the Managing Director of the respondent-Corporation to look into the matter as regards non-release of subsistence allowance against the backdrop of a representation dated 13.2.2019 (Annexure P-7) that has already been made.

The prayer made by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent no.2 i.e. the Managing Director, PUNSUP to look into the matter as regards non-release of subsistence allowance to the petitioner and to thereafter take a final decision on the representation dated 13.2.2019 (Annexure P-7) within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
