Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh, has submitted that respondents No.4 and 5 have joined the enquiry and they have suffered the statements to the effect that they have no objection to the marriage between the petitioners and they have undertaken not to interfere in their married life.

The petitioners who are also present in Court along with their counsel reiterated the same thing and stated that now they do not have any threat to their life and liberty.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition, if in future, there is any threat to their life and liberty.
