The allegations against petitioner Gagandeep Bassi have been levelled by complainant/wife Renu Bassi that the marriage between the couple was solemnized on 12.05.2009 and on the asking of the accused side, sufficient dowry articles were given, however,

during the course of matrimony disputes had arisen on account of demand of more dowry, physical abuse and mental pressure leading to the registration of the present case.

Mr. G.S. Madaan, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that parties have effected a settlement and has sought to revert back the report of the Mediator dated 14.05.2019, which is conceded to at the bar by the complainant alongwith her counsel Mr. Vishal Munjal and even learned State counsel on instructions of HC Mander Singh concedes to that effect. Thus, in the light of the same and the fact that the parties have settled the dispute and it would be travesty of justice, if the accused is sent behind the bars, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to the anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
