In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.27 dated 19.04.2019 under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

2 This Court vide order dated 17.05.2019 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3 Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jagtar Singh, Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur states that in pursuance of the order dated 17.05.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and that he is not required for further custodial interrogation.

4 In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of case, the order dated 17.05.2019, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5 However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6 Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
