Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in cross-case bearing DRR No.24 dated 18.09.2018 under Sections 354, 354-A, 323, 506, 34 IPC in FIR No.130 dated 17.09.2018 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3(i)(R) of the SC&ST Act added vide DDR No.26 dated 16.10.2018, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that apart from the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation, the offence under Section 3(i)(R) of the SC&ST Act had already been deleted in the DDR.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdata Pal,

submits that in the aforesaid DDR, the police has investigated the matter and has already prepared a cancellation report and the same is in the process of being filed in the Court.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the aforesaid development so stated by learned State Counsel, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide orders dated 15.10.2018 and 30.10.2018 is made absolute.
