The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 21.6.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 506, 509 of Indian Penal Code and under Section 10 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, at Police Station Women, Sector 16-A, District Faridabad.

Heard.

The allegations have been levelled against the petitioner is that he along with his associate have been harassing the sister of the complainant.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
- (v) the petitioner will maintain good behaviour during the period of bail.
