This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 17.11.1999, under Sections 454, 380, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Goraya, Tehsil Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Admittedly, the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and being proclaimed offender, he is not entitled for grant of anticipatory bail. Earlier, petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 20.08.2018 with liberty to him to avail the appropriate remedy.

No ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
