Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed against the order dated 11.06.2015 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Narnaul, refusing to summon the accused to face trial for having committed the alleged offence which has been affirmed in revision.

Complainant-petitioner alleges that her son was killed by the accused by giving injuries on the private parts.

Both the Courts have found that medico legal report does not corroborate the oral evidence. Further, it has been found that as per the report of Chemical Examiner, cause of death is the presence of Ethyle Alcohol which was estimated to be 80.5% mg.

Keeping in view the aforesaid findings, there is no ground to interfere.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
