JASWANT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Dhanna Singh has filed the instant writ petition seeking writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents i.e. District Development and Panchayat Officer, Sangrur and Block Development Officer, Lehra, District Sangrur to initiate proceedings on the complaint filed by petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner had moved numerous complaints against the encroachers of the land belonging to *Shamlat Deh* for the concerned authorities-respondents herein, however, neither any action has been taken on the said complaints nor demarcation of land belonging to Panchayat has been done.

We have heard learned Counsel for the petitioner at

length and have perused the paper book with his assistance. However, we are of the opinion that instant writ petition is without any merit and, therefore, deserves dismissal.

In case petitioner has any grievance, he can very well approach the appropriate authority for redressal of his grievance and not file instant writ petition. We cannot pass sweeping directions in such kind of cases, which may affect the rights of some other persons.

Consequently, finding no merit in the instant writ petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
