Report dated 04.07.2019 of learned Judicial
Magistrate 1st Class, Ferozepur has been received whereby
after recording statements of petitioners Gurkirat and
Rajinder Singh and complainant Jaswinder Kaur, the Court
has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been
arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without

any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure small personal one over use of hand pump and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 32 dated 12.03.2017 registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur, under Sections 354-B, 325, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, all consequences arising out of the said FIR

qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
