This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.7 dated 27.1.2017 registered under Sections 302/34 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/27 Arms Act at police station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody for 1 ½ years and two eye witnesses have been turned hostile.

Learned Sr. DAG on instructions from ASI Naib Singh has accepted these assertions.

Custody certificate dated 23.5.2019 by way of affidavit of Vipanjit Singh, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. The custody certificate also

certifies the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for 1 year 6 months and 15 days.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly, Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
