FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Vaibhav Bansal in case bearing FIR No.250 dated 18.09.2018 registered at Police Station City Sangrur under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 15.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurtej Singh, Police Station City Sangrur who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view thereof and the fact that the parties have effected a compromise which is not disputed by learned counsel for respondent No.2 Mr. Ankush Singla, Advocate and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.10.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the complainant further contends that the matter be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

In view thereof, the petition stands disposed off. However, the parties shall appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for sorting out the issues within fifteen days from today.
