Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurjant Singh, Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur submits that the petitioners have since joined the investigations and are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute though on behalf of the complainant Mr. Arihant Goyal, counsel for the complainant has sought to oppose the grant of bail on the grounds that the gold ornaments have not been recovered.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 22.10.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan).

Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
