Present petition has been filed for issuance of order or direction, directing the respondents especially respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further directing the respondent No.4 not to harass, humiliate physically and mentally torture the petitioners.

This Court has already held in another petition i.e. CRM-M-20457-2019 decided on 06.05.2019 that unless the statutory proceedings have already been initiated by a statutory authority or Court under Code of Criminal Procedure(for short, 'Cr.P.C'), the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is not maintainable for issuance of any direction. The remedy is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
